June 20th & 21st Immersive Abstract

Immerse yourself in color. Each new swath of paint sits atop what came before, sometimes translucent, sometimes opaque. The color itself becomes the protagonist. Warm tones might pulse and expand; cool tones withdraw and calm. Your emotional response is the painting's narrative. Paint with an artist's hand: sweeping arcs, energetic splatters, tiny rhythmic taps. Sometimes you'll sense a dance across the canvas; other times a whisper of stillness. An abstract work like this doesn't prescribe a meaning. This painting's beauty lies in the dialogue between color, form, material –and ultimately, the viewer's own thought s and feelings. July 18th & 19th Image Trail
