Easel: portable canvas-supporting easel, table easel, or the gallery will loan you one.

Oil paints: cadmium red light, naphthol red or Grumbacher Red (If you can't find it, Judy will have a few tubes at the workshop), alizarin crimson, burnt sienna, ultramarine blue, Prussian blue, cadmium yellow light, yellow ochre, cadmium orange, sap green, titanium white.

Brushes: #8, #10, and #12 bright bristle (not synthetic), #2 round bristle (for sketching)

Judy prefers Lexington II brushed by Windsor and Newton.

Palette (disposable is fine). Palette knife

Primed canvases or prepared boards: 16 x 20 or smaller

Jar with odorless paint thinner, mineral spirits, turpenoid, or turpenoid natural.

Paper towels. Optional: baby wipes (these are great hand cleaners!)

Reference material: original photos taken by you or someone you know, preferably of rather simple scenes with lots of light and shadow.

## EXPERIMENTAL WORKSHOPS WITH KAREN FOSTER

*Each two-day workshop will take a different path, each providing new concepts and techniques and plenty of time to explore and create.*

### **JAN. 16 & 17: EARTH AS A CANVAS**

We'll translate satellite imagery into expressive artworks that reimagine earth's surface as a canvas. You will gain practice in transforming reality into the elements of painting-line, shape, color, value and texture.

**FEE:** \$125 for the two-day workshop

**TIME:** 9:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

**SUPPLY LIST:** acrylic paint, canvas or panel, (approximate good sizes, 16x20 or a square in 18x18 or 20x20) , a variety of paintbrushes, pencil, black permanent pen, reference photo-aerial view from Google Earth, tracing paper. Optional: any texture making mediums such as glass gel beads, fiber paste, clear tar gel, Golden's Micaceous Iron Oxide, etc. All mediums are found in the mediums under the paint brands. These are not necessary and hopefully we can share what we have.

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### **MARCH 20 – 21: Motif Tapestry**

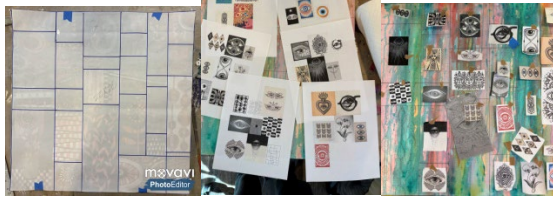
A *Motif* can be any subject that you have a fondness for such as insects, leaves, flowers, trees, hearts, tea cups, symbols, paisley patterns, fish, suns, moons, etc. The subjects are really endless but only choose one idea. Karen will be doing "Eyes" as her subject.

Each of you will be guided to create a grid using the photos you bring. Below is an example of Karen's grid that she will be using on a 20"x20" canvas. See canvas size recommendation in supply list.

### SUPPLY LIST

The substrate you choose is a personal choice. Karen's piece is a 20"x20" and will take many hours of work outside of classroom. You may wish to choose a more reasonable size such as a 12"x12" gallery wrapped canvas.

Acrylic paints

CLEAR Gesso

3 squeeze bottles

Carbon paper

Tracing paper

Pencil and/ or a red or blue pen

2-3" wide brush

Micron pen, size 03 or 05 or similar.

Posca pens in gray tones: Slate Grey, Deep Grey, Grey and Black (size PC 5M bullet shaped) Karen might also use a Sky Blue and Ivory. You may use another brand of paint pens if you have them.

Apron

Paper towels

Long ruler

Plastic table covers

Photo copies of your favorite Motif; small, medium, and large.
